

Where's the COMMUNITY in your community survey?


In the Nashville Promise Neighborhood, the community has been knocking on its own doors, and the results have been worth it! Over the course of three weekends they were able to get 485 door-to-door surveys completed. Residents were paired with trained AmeriCorps members, agency staff, and grad school students for the data collection push, which benefitted from community knowledge, built social capital, and increased the response rate.
