



**This is the closest you'll get to a gun if you're convicted of domestic violence.**

Under federal law, if you're convicted of domestic violence, or subject to a restraining order for domestic violence, you can't possess a gun. That means if you buy a gun, borrow a gun or use a gun, you can go to federal prison. If you have questions about the federal firearms laws, call 1-800-ATF-GUNS.
