The term *expansion* indicates that grant funds were used to expand (add bed or call space) to a previously existing facility. The term *renovation* indicates that grant funds were used to construct non-bed or non-cell space (e.g.. kitchen, exercise room, etc.). The term *security upgrades* indicates that grant funds were used to provide security upgrades in or around the facility (e.g. perimeter fences, cameras, etc.). The term *leased space* indicates that grant funds were used to lease or contract bed space.
