3. Reduce barriers to successful re-entry by addressing offender needs

4. Improve continuity between pre and post-release services for high risk offenders with identified needs

Provide services to address offenders' identified needs prior to their release from prison/jail

Develop transition plans for offenders prior to their release

Identify community-based service providers for the provision of post-release services

Establish formal relationships with community-based service providers

Provide services to offenders upon their release based on transition plan or other identified needs

Number of offenders with a transition plan developed prior to release during this reporting period



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Theory
IF all offenders sentenced to prison/jail are assessed for risk and needs and IF offenders with a high risk of re-offending are admitted to a reentry program and IF these needs are addressed via treatment and training prior to and following their release from prison/jail THEN these offenders will be more likely to successfully integrate into the community and less likely to commit new crimes and to return to jail or prison than high risk offenders who do not participate in the reentry program.
